



OPERANDUM Project

The OPERANDUM European project has started as frame in the European Horizon 2020 program in which Naturalea, together with 21 other partners among universities, companies and NGOs from 12 countries, will focus on reducing the hydro-meteorological risks of rural areas in Europe through nature-based solutions (NBS) to better understand its functioning and mitigate the effects of these risks on the climate change scenarios that arise in Europe.

The project aims to provide scientific based evidence for the usability of NBS through the design, development, use, testing and demonstration of innovations in these spaces with the establishment of 7 open-air laboratories (OALs) in areas of the continent where risks have been detected or where studies have already begun to be carried out on ecosystem services and want to be monitored and improve these areas.

OPERANDUM aims to be a multidisciplinary 4-year project where research, experience, new technologies, political actions and stakeholders are mixed so that Europe improves the leadership in the applicability and policies of nature-based solutions, NBS.
